A NOTE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear St. Mark Parish Family,

As a Catholic Parish Community, we at St. Mark Parish are all embarked on a journey of Life and Faith. It is a great comfort to know that others are on the same road as we are. When we register with a parish, we are saying that it is our wish to travel down this road of Life and Faith with that particular community of people by becoming active in its mission and vision, and supporting it. In fact, the word parish comes from the Greek word "paroikia" meaning "a pilgrim people," a people on a journey of faith; a journey that we hope one day will lead to the fullness of life in God's Kingdom forever.

Living in a culture that no longer supports a religious way of life, much less a Catholic Christian way of life, the local parish plays an integral role in helping to guide and support us on our journey. The parish does this through its educational and formational programs, prayer groups, spiritual development, and celebrations of the Word and Sacraments. By these means, the parish empowers, nourishes and enables us to grow in wisdom, healing and grace before God and our world.

The parish cannot exist and grow as a separate entity without the active ongoing relationship among those who compose it. When registering with a parish a person is entering into a relationship, and just like any other relationship, if it's to be viable and healthy, there must be mutual commitment with it's members. The fact is the most basic and necessary description of an active Catholic is a person who, besides participation in the Mass and the sacraments, seeks to live out the Catholic faith in the ordinary circumstances of his or her life.

Before we serve God in the parish, we serve Him first in our homes, as parents, children, spouses, and as single persons, and in society at large as workers, professionals and citizens. Being an active Catholic in our places of work does not mean that we go around preaching to others. It means acting out our faith in the knowledge that actions speak louder than words. Each profession or job brings with it a whole host of possibilities for serving the kingdom of God and embodying the Catholic faith. Each one of us is called to be an active Catholic. This does not begin and end with what we do on Sunday morning. Certainly, the liturgical aspect of faith is central. But being an active Catholic means living our faith in the ordinary circumstances of life Monday through Saturday.
