A NOTE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear St. Mark Parish Family,

We have been blessed here at St. Mark to recently present the 2nd session of 3 in an evangelization series from Christ Life. Last fall we began with Discovering Christ, and have just recently completed Following Christ. Beginning in October we will end with the final series, Sharing Christ.

I want to share with you an evaluation summary of Following Christ below, and as you read through this please pray about joining in the next time we begin the series:

"Following Christ has shown me the need to read scripture for a better understanding and a desire to dive into Scripture"..."Helped me to start putting more energy into daily prayer, helped me learn about my faith, and very helpful sharing and learning with others"..." Spending more time in private prayer, reading the Bible and listening to what Jesus wants me to do in my life"..." Meeting people on the same journey and sharing... to provide support and encouragement"..." provided me with the opportunity to more closely walk with Jesus...helped me have a deeper walk in faith"..." Made me understand praise and worship and a deeper prayer life"..."Words are hard to describe. This has opened my mind and heart to love, peace and happiness. I find peace in my mind as I read through the booklet...how to forgive others and myself"..."It has begun a real hunger in me to learn all I can about Christ...I look forward each day to reading scripture and applying it to my life"..." My life open to the Holy Spirit, reading scripture, my prayers and what He is saying to me each morning...feel joyful and full of the Holy Spirit"..."Improved and changed my life"..."Has helped me not only personally but also helping others as their needs arise...started really getting into scripture"..."Started daily prayer life"..."Joy, stopping my brain and listening...starting to pray and not recite prayer...forgiving was difficult"..."Discovered how powerful the actual words of God are in my life, how true and direct they are." "Small group discussions were valuable"..."I am more accepting of others and their differences"..." Great meeting wonderful people who were so inspiring...a sense of community"..."Helped me improve my daily prayer. Opened my mind to my own faults and how to forgive the faults in others"..."I have become brave...sharing my spiritual journey stories with people who accept and understand has given me strength to share with everyone my joy...Learning how scripture changes our lives and informs us in everything we do...praising God has also become first in my life"..."Made me more aware of changes I want to do to bring me closer to the Lord especially in prayer and praise...Bringing out the importance and value of music, singing and prayer in my faith"..."Following Christ has definitely drawn me in...it is guiding me to what I need to do, having felt the need to grow deeper in my faith since I was feeling very disconnected no matter how much I prayed. I feel like I just recite in prayer, but feel called to do the Bible in a year"..."All sessions were very good, changed the way I personally pray, instead of one way I branched out"..." More daily prayer, better listening to the Bible readings, placed more trust in Jesus to help me in my life"..."I have come closer to many people in our community. Fellowship is such an integral part of our faith walk... impacted by the session of prayer and praying personally for one another"..."I am more constantly aware of Christ's presence in my daily life. I can feel Christ as a real part of me and all my activities. Following Christ has made it all so real, Christ is real, not just a statue"..."More aware of the Holy Spirit involvement in my every day experiences...thoughts of new activities that I'll be able to do to be involved more in parish activities"..." All sessions were dynamic in bringing me closer to Christ. Made me realize that the practice of my faith was somewhat shallow and needed more depth and refinement."

I encourage you to ask the Lord to draw you close to Him, to reveal Himself to you in a new way as He has done for those have that have been a part of the ChristLife series. Living in His love, fully embracing it, will bring you so much PEACE and JOY!
