#### A NOTE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear St. Mark Parish Family,

I would like to share some prayerful thoughts on Stewardship!

A steward is a servant entrusted for a time with the goods of the Master. The steward uses but does not own these goods, and must eventually give an account to the Master for the way in which they have been cared for and made fruitful.

Each of us spends a brief time in this life, preparing for our eternal life with God. While we are here, we receive everything from God, even life itself, and are asked to make good use of what God has entrusted to us. We are invited by God to be good stewards of His gifts. It is no wonder that the idea of stewardship plays such a central role in the life of faith.

St. Paul, in his letter to the Ephesians, gives us an important theme to reflect on Stewardship. "You have heard of the stewardship of God's grace that was given to me for your benefit...that the mystery was made known to me by revelation." Stewardship represents the duties of the steward of someone else's possessions. we give gifts as a sign of our love for Christ, our love for each other, and our understanding of the gifts we have all received.

We trust the Biblical words of St. Paul because we know God entrusted him with the truth of the Gospel message. All of us are invited by God to trust that God has given us each the gift of life, and the blessings of our natural and spiritual gifts to be a steward for the world. We are each a steward of God's creative order.

We are called to know ourselves so we can know our gifts and best share them with the world. St. Mark parish family, may we live true Christian stewardship, in thanksgiving for all the Lord has entrusted to us. May the Lord continue to bless us with joy and peace as disciples of Jesus and help us to be always ready for the gift of eternal life in Heaven!
