A NOTE FROM BR. KEVIN, A REFLECTION ABOUT APPS

Dear St. Mark Parish Family,

Thank you for having me back into the parish! Oh, was I gone??? ;-) I returned to the U.S. recently from a trip to Europe. However, the trip was not for vacation. I attended a six-month program for Trinitarians who are preparing for solemn vows. I had three groupmates, one each from Brazil, Republic of the Congo, and South Korea.

The APPS (Anio de Preparacion para Profesion Solemne) program presented us with sessions from Trinitarians about the Trinitarians. We reviewed subjects including the Order's history, its charisms, and living a Trinitarian life. Many of our sessions were blocked into one of three categories, categories we ALL can live to lead a life in the Trinity: community/fraternity, mission, and prayer. In short, our sessions challenged us to know what it means to be a Trinitarian and how to live out our charisms of Glory to the Trinity and Release of the Captives.

We lived in the Order's first house in Rome (San Carlino). The house is about 481 years old (older than the U.S.!) and is part of our Spanish province. The house is just east of the Vatican, close to many interesting sights. This was good for us, especially during class, because we were able to partake in a few "we just studied it, now let's see it" moments!

We were blessed to meet Pope Francis on our third day of the program, at the end of a papal audience. We also were blessed to participate in a special Mass for religious, at which the pope presided. Fr. Santhosh brought a little bit of "home" to me when he and some other Trinitarians came to Rome in April for our SIT (Solidarity International Trinitarians) conference, which is centered on persecuted Christians. The meeting culminated with a papal audience followed by a tour of the catacombs beneath St. Peter Basilica!

When all was completed in Rome, we went to France for a week of retreat. This happened at our first house, just outside Paris. The house is adjacent to the woods where the Order's founders met! The retreat allowed us time to contemplate what being a Trinitarian means for us. We also had a couple quick excursions into Paris afterwards.

The APPS was a very enriching time for us. We were afforded the time to integrate our theological educations with our Trinitarian life interpretations. Because we are members of a religious order (Order of the Most Holy Trinity – O.SS.T.), being a Trinitarian comes first with all else flowing as ministries. This is why solemn vows are very important for us! This is why the program was even envisioned. Two of my groupmates will celebrate their solemn vows this month and one will celebrate vows next month. My vows are scheduled for Saturday, October 29, 2022 @ 10am in St. Mark's church building (pending approval of our provincial council). Everyone is, of course, welcome to attend.

Thank you for having me back! Dorothy's right...there is no place like home!


