A NOTE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear St. Mark Parish Family,

This is the day the Lord has made! We should be glad and rejoice! Indeed, we are rejoicing as St. Mark parish will soon welcome the addition of three Sisters of CMC (Congregation of the Mother of Carmel) a religious community that originated in India. The Charism of the Congregation is 'personal sanctity and redemptive uplift of the people of God especially women and children, through the right blending of contemplation and action'.

Presently they have around 6,300 sisters belonging to 24 Provinces and 4 Regions. These sisters are involved mostly in various missionary activities in Germany, Italy, Canada, UK, Iraq, Peru, Central Africa, Kenya, Malawi, South Africa, Sudan, Tanzania and India. They have a regional headquarters in Chicago for recruitment and formation.

Two sisters will join us in October and a third, Sr. Navya Thomas CMC, will join the community in 6 months' time. Sr. Vandana Joseph CMC is a nurse and will be working at St. Agnes Hospital. She has been serving in the USA for 22 years. Sr. Sajeeva Maria CMC became a nun in 2006 and has been serving in the rural areas of India as a nurse, visiting the poor and the sick, helping them in their medical and material needs.

This religious community will bless our parish campus with their presence, prayerfulness, attendance at Masses, interaction with the school children, and love through service to others as Christ. During these challenging church times, it is a rarity to find religious sisters in a parish. We are blessed to have several religious communities attend daily Mass at St. Mark. God has truly blessed our St. Mark parish.

The sisters' religious charisms of joy, peace, love, and compassion will add to the holiness here at St. Mark. Relocating from Louisiana to Maryland, the sisters will soon reside near our parish and begin their ministry. As with most changes in residence, there are household items that the sisters are in need of, specifically: a bedroom set, bedroom dressers, bed linens, lamps, rugs, 4 sitting chairs, tables for use in their chapel, plates, utensils, shower curtain, bath towels, vacuum cleaner, broom and cleaning supplies. Please contact the office if you'd like to donate item(s) or make a financial gift to be used to help set up their new household.

I am delighted to share this good news, as this new community has been under consideration for quite a few months and has now been approved by the Archbishop and the Archdiocese of Baltimore. Soon, in October, we will meet these sisters as they join our parish family. Added information will be forthcoming. Indeed, we have cause to be rejoicing!

We are very happy and blessed to have these wonderful sisters in our parish of Saint Mark. As their schedule permits, they will come to both daily Mass and Sunday Mass here and they will be actively involved in our ministries and parish life. Please, as you always do, give them a warm Saint Mark welcome! Please keep them in your prayers that they may have a successful apostolate in our parish and the Archdiocese, and help many people come closer to the Lord through their service.

Sisters, we sincerely hope you feel at home here. We build lasting and rewarding relationships with God, parishioners, and our community. By building these relationships, we foster a sense of belonging; thus, growing, receiving, and giving to one another.


